WEDNESDAY IS THE SOLEMNITY OF ALL SAINTS

Heaven is God's space, where full reality exists, close by our ordinary ('earthly') reality and interlocking with it. One day heaven and earth will be joined together for ever and the true state of affairs, at present out of sight, will be unveiled.

We are to pray that God's kingdom will come, and God's will be done, 'on earth as it is in heaven'. The life of heaven - the life of the realm where God is already king - is to become the life of the world, transforming the present 'earth' into the place of beauty and delight that God always intended. Those who follow Jesus are to begin to live by this rule here and now. That's the point of the Sermon on the Mount and these 'beatitudes' in particular. They are a summons to live in the present in the way that will make sense in God's promised future; because that future has arrived in the present in Jesus of Nazareth. It may seem upside down, but we are called to believe, with great daring, that it is in fact the right way up. Try it and see.
