for all things speak of You.

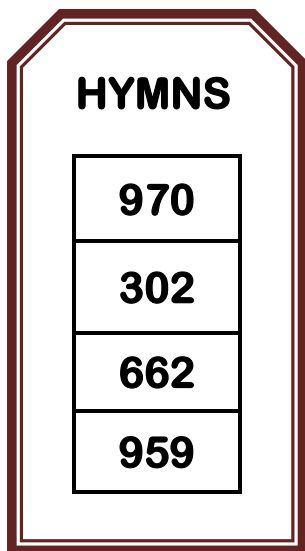
Give us the grace to recognize, respect and protect
